Google Like a Librarian!

Assistant Director of Access Services, **Daniel Laikko** says, *"I HATE running into a roadblock while researching. I've spent a lot of time over the years trying to get around them so I can find what I need and finish my work faster."*

One thing I love to use is Google Scholar's "Cited By" feature. Let's say I have only one good article that's relevant to me, but maybe it's out of date. I can use this feature and find articles that have been published since then that cite this article in its bibliography.

I find this to be extremely helpful, as these articles are often discussing the same topic, but maybe in new and exciting directions I hadn't thought of previously. Try it out!"
