### Google Like a Librarian

Assistant Director of Teaching, Learning & Assessment, Tina Dent says, "I'm a big fan of using "-" in search strings to filter out unwanted or unhelpful terms. For example, a simple Google search on The Grapes of Wrath will bring up lots of results related to the book as well as film and TV adaptations. If you just want to research the film, you can use: grapes of wrath novel -steinbeck to help filter out unnecessary results."
